Melton trailers have air-ride, spread axle suspension and offer 48,000lbs legal payload capacity. 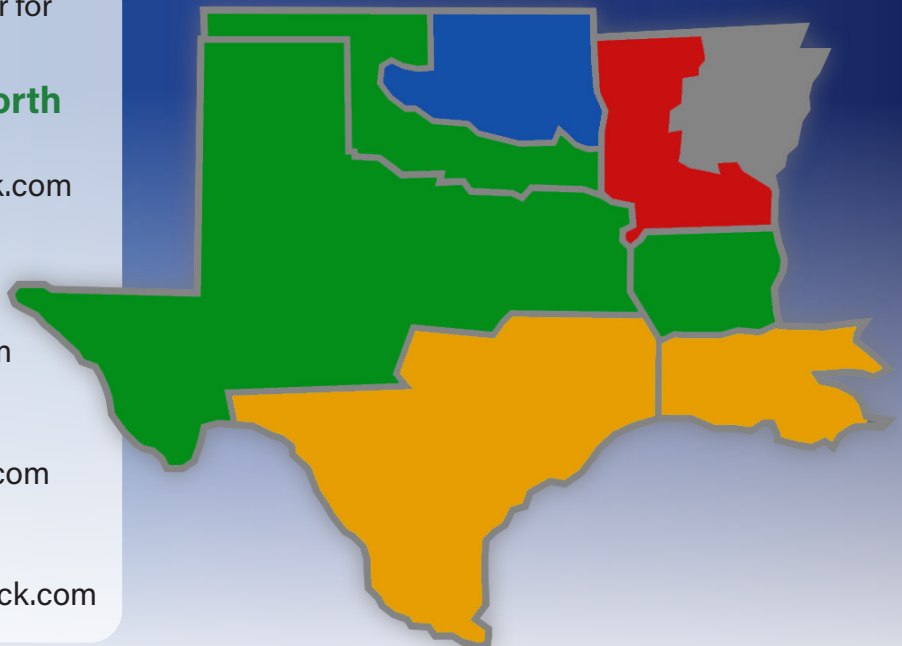

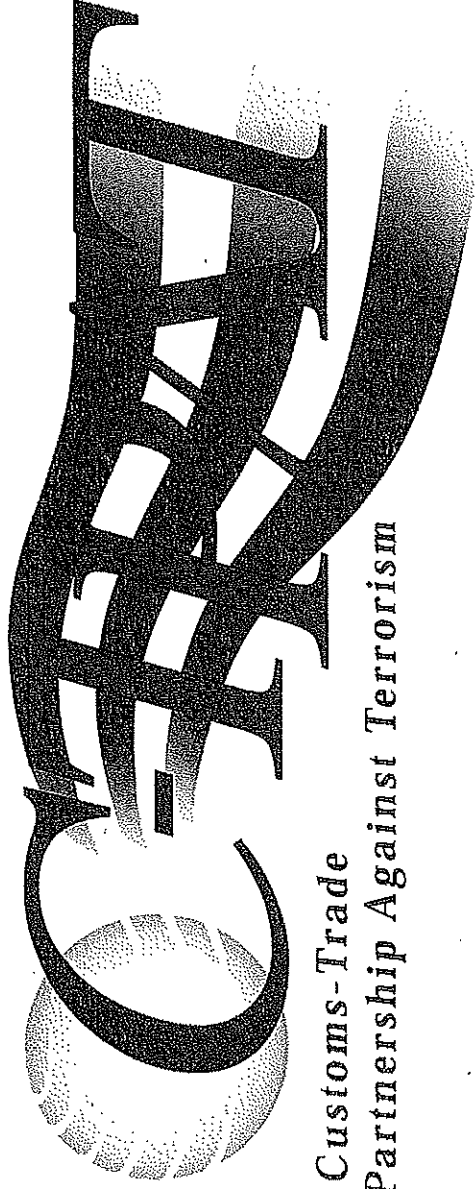

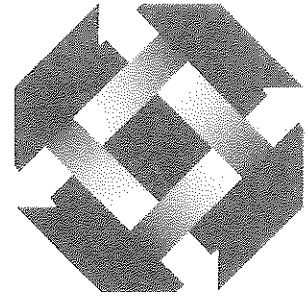
